

Candidates seeking admission to M.Com degree should have majored in B.Com., B.B.A., degree course and those reading M.A., Tamil should have done B.A. Tamil

Procedure for Admission

The application form complete in all respects should be submitted with the required certificates (as specified in the application form) immediately after the publication of plus two results at the admission office of the College. The Admission officer after scrutinizing the certificates and taking into consideration marks and reservation criteria may recommend spot admission to the Principal. The principal will finally grant spot admission to the deserving candidates.

College Life

Teacher's Day

Apart from end of Semester examinations conducted by the University, each department will conduct 3 C.A. examinations of three hour duration each. Apart from these there will be quizzes, weekly/daily tests and seminars. Internal assessment marks are equally distributed between these exams/tests. So, students should take these exams/ seriously. Any absence in any of these results in losing marks in the final internal Assessment. Practical/Vivavoce / Examinations

BHRD

The college is offering a three year parallel programme in Basics in Human Resource Development. We have an MOU with CLHRD, Mangalore. This course, though not recognized by any university, is industry recognized. The course is student friendly and lecture hours are very minimal. The course is so structured that there is thrust on student initiative. It includes such components as cluster study, self study, library study and projects. The students have the freedom to opt out in the first year, when they will be issued a certificate, or in the second year, when they will be issued a diploma. Those who complete the third year will get a certificate equivalent to a degree. We are also happy to remind the public that from this year the UGC has approved 2 parallel degree courses. So, we are a pioneer in this. The intake of the students is restricted to 30 only. Last year we introduced this course as an Add-on course and it is very popular as academic tours to historical places and Art galleries are built into academics.
